What is the overall deductible?	In Network: \$500/Individual, \$1,000/Family Out of Network: Not Covered	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. <u>Preventive care/screening</u> /immunization, Primary Care, <u>Specialist</u> Care, <u>Urgent Care</u> , and <u>Mental/Behavioral Health</u> , and <u>Substance Abuse</u> <u>Outpatient Services</u> do not apply toward the <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply.
